AI Overview

A core switch connects to an OLT via Ethernet or optical interfaces, enabling the OLT to manage upstream and downstream traffic between the service provider's backbone and end-user ONTs.

OLT Overview An Optical Line Terminal (OLT) is the central control unit of a Passive Optical Network (PON), typically located in a service provider's central office or data center. It serves as the interface between the provider's core network and multiple Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) or Optical Network Units (ONUs) at the subscriber side. The OLT converts standard Ethernet/IP signals into optical signals, manages bandwidth allocation, and coordinates communication with all connected ONTs.

Connection to Core Switch The core switch is the high-capacity network switch in the provider's backbone that aggregates traffic from multiple OLTs. The connection between a core switch and an OLT is typically established via: Ethernet interfaces (1G, 10G, or higher) using SFP/SFP+ modules for short or long-distance links. Optical fiber links for high-speed, long-distance connectivity, supporting GPON or EPON protocols. This connection allows the OLT to forward downstream traffic from the core network to ONTs and receive upstream traffic from ONTs for delivery to the core network.

Traffic Management The OLT handles both upstream and downstream traffic:

- Downstream:** The OLT encapsulates Ethernet services into GEM frames (GPON) or equivalent PON frames, assigns port IDs, and broadcasts them to all ONTs. Each ONT filters and decapsulates the frames for the end user.
- Upstream:** ONTs send data in allocated time slots using T-CONTs (Transmission Containers), which the OLT decapsulates and forwards to the core switch. The OLT also performs bandwidth allocation, traffic grooming, and QoS management, ensuring efficient delivery of bursty traffic from multiple subscribers.
