Installation Best Practices

- Use Fiber Raceway Systems:** Installing fiber optic raceways within open trays provides continuous support and protection. Dry-fit raceway sections on the ground, label them, and lift into position using two-person lifts. Ensure proper alignment, level, and expansion gaps.
- Bracket and Fastener Placement:** Install brackets centered under the raceway, using stainless steel fasteners tightened to the correct torque. Brackets should be level within $\pm 2^\circ$ and spaced to prevent sagging.
- Cable Handling:** Maintain the minimum bend radius and limit pulling tension (typically max 25 lbs). Secure cables with ties every 600mm and use bend radius protectors at turns.
- Grounding:** Install grounding straps every 30 feet using 6 AWG copper wire connected to the building ground. Test continuity to ensure resistance is below 1 ohm.
- Expansion and Flexibility:** Use expansion joints every 30 feet and flexible connectors or segmented raceway sections to navigate obstacles like HVAC ducts while maintaining bend radius.

NEC Compliance

According to the 2023 National Electric Code (NEC), any listed optical fiber cable is acceptable for tray applications. Unlike power cables, fiber optic cables do not require a specific tray rating, but proper installation ensures mechanical protection and long-term reliability. Open trays are considered different from fully enclosed raceways, so extra care is needed to prevent physical damage.
