Optical fiber consists of a core and a cladding, selected for due to the difference in the refractive index between the two. The (DF) IRU "shall mean the exclusive, unrestricted, and indefeasible right to use one, a pair, or more strands of fiber of a fiber cable for any legal purpose". With an IRU contractual arrangement, the buyer of the IRU can unconditionally, and exclusively, use the fibers of the IRU for a long time period, around 25–30 years. In this case it is called "dark" since it has to be lit by the IRU owner, not the cable's owner. The
