QSFP+ and QSFP28: Often use MPO/MTP connectors, supporting multi-channel fiber connections for 40G or 100G links. QSFP-DD modules, a double-density variant, also use MPO/MTP connectors for high-speed applications. CFP: Uses larger form-factor ports compatible with high-speed telecommunication links, often supporting single-mode fiber with LC or MPO interfaces. CXP: Designed for short-distance multimode links, providing 12 parallel channels in each direction, typically using MPO connectors. CSFP: Compact SFP modules with two bidirectional transceivers inside a single SFP form factor, usually using LC connectors. Key Considerations When selecting an optical module, it is important to verify: Connector type (LC, MPO, MTP) to match the fiber infrastructure. Fiber type (single-mode vs multimode) for compatibility. Data rate and module form factor to ensure the port supports the intended speed (e.g., 1G, 10G, 25G, 40G, 100G). Hot-pluggability and MSA compliance for interchangeability between vendors. In summary, the port type of an optical module is determined by its form factor and application, with LC connectors common for SFP modules and MPO/MTP connectors used for high-density, high-speed modules like QSFP and QSFP-DD.
