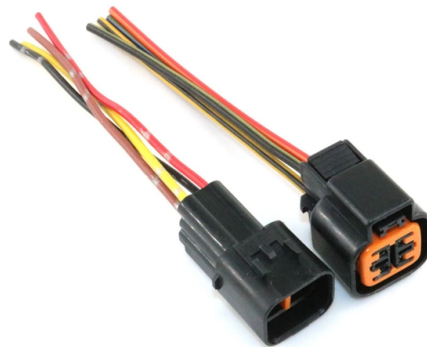


Parallel Cable Tray Installation Techniques

Secure trays with bolts, clamps, or welding as per manufacturer specifications. Installation Procedure Mark the tray route on walls, ceilings, or floors. Install supports at designated intervals. Position the first tray and level it using a spirit level. Install additional trays in parallel, maintaining consistent spacing and alignment.
