Neutral (N) Wire Connection: For 1P breakers, the neutral bypasses the breaker and connects directly to the neutral busbar. For 2P breakers, the neutral is also switched ().

Protective Earth (PE) Wire: Must be connected to the ground busbar, especially for breakers with residual current protection (RCDs), to prevent earth faults ().

Recommended Procedure for Patching

De-energize the Circuit: Switch off the main breaker or the specific branch breaker to isolate the circuit.

Verify Absence of Voltage: Use a voltage tester or multimeter to confirm the circuit is de-energized.

Use Proper Tools: Insulated tools rated for the system voltage should be used to prevent accidental contact with live parts.

Secure Connections: Ensure all wire connections are tight and properly insulated. Use wire nuts or terminal blocks as appropriate.

Restore Power Safely: After completing the patch, double-check all connections, close the panel cover, and then re-energize the breaker.
