If deviations exceed a set threshold, typically $\pm 10^\circ$, the relay disables the motor starter within a few cycles. Older models may use electromechanical or static designs, where a rotating magnetic field or electronic components detect the phase order.

Protective Actions Phase sequence relays provide protection by:

- Preventing reverse rotation:** Motors and pumps can spin backward if the phase sequence is wrong, causing mechanical stress, bearing wear, and shaft misalignment.
- Avoiding single-phasing:** If one phase is lost, the relay trips the supply to prevent overheating and excessive current draw.
- Ensuring correct generator synchronization:** In power plants, relays prevent out-of-phase paralleling that could damage generators.
- Safeguarding elevators and HVAC systems:** Relays maintain correct rotation direction, preventing operational hazards and equipment failure.

- Industrial motors and pumps:** To prevent reverse rotation and mechanical damage.
- Generator synchronization:** Ensuring proper phase alignment before paralleling.
- Elevator and hoist systems:** Protecting against incorrect phase sequence that could cause unsafe operation.
