

Placement of distribution box in cable well

A distribution box can be safely installed inside a cable well if it is properly mounted, ventilated, waterproofed, and accessible for maintenance.

If connecting to another unit, ensure an external fuse is installed before the distribution box.

Safety and Testing Switch off the main power before starting any connections. After installation, perform insulation resistance, grounding, and current tests to verify proper operation. Label all circuits clearly for future maintenance and troubleshooting. Consider adding circuit breakers, fuses, or surge protectors for each branch circuit to enhance safety.
