Impact on Relay Protection Protective relays are traditionally designed for fixed network topologies with deterministic fault currents. DA introduces dynamic changes in network configuration, which can affect relay operation and coordination: Topology changes: Automatic switching or reconfiguration can alter current flow directions and fault levels, impacting relay zones and coordination. Distributed generation: DERs like solar PV or battery storage can inject fault currents from multiple points, requiring relays to adapt to bidirectional flows. FLISR operations: During fault isolation and service restoration, feeder segments may temporarily shift sources, necessitating adaptive relay settings to prevent misoperation. Voltage and reactive power control: DA actions such as VVO can influence relay pickup thresholds and timing, requiring careful coordination.
