Factors Affecting Pricing

Fiber Type: Single-mode fibers are more expensive per foot but allow longer runs and higher bandwidth, making them cost-effective for long-term scalability.

Cable Construction: Plenum-rated, armored, or outdoor-rated cables cost more than standard indoor riser-rated cables.

Connectorization: Pre-terminated cables or high-density connectors (LC, SC, MPO/MTP) add to the cost.

Strand Count: More fiber strands increase material costs proportionally; for example, a 12-strand cable may cost around \$0.50 per foot, while a 24-strand cable can reach \$1.00 per foot.

Project Scale: Bulk purchases reduce per-foot costs by 20–40% compared to retail quantities.
