Overview of Three-Level Distribution Boxes

A three-level distribution system consists of:

- Primary (Main) Distribution Box:** Connects directly to the transformer, serving as the central hub for 0.4kV power. Equipped with isolating switches, circuit breakers, and residual current devices (RCDs) to protect the entire system.
- Secondary Distribution Box:** Distributes power to specific buildings or floors, often handling three-phase loads. Features dual-door protection, durable coatings, and rainproof designs for outdoor use.
- Tertiary Distribution Box:** Supplies individual equipment or home systems with 220V single-phase power. Implements strict safety standards such as “one device, one circuit breaker, one RCD, one box” and may be fixed or portable.

Protection Measures

- Leakage Protection (Two-Level Protection)**
Install RCDs at both the secondary and tertiary levels to prevent electric shock and equipment damage. Follow the principle of “one machine, one switch, one leakage, one box, one lock” to avoid multiple devices sharing a single protection device.
- Surge Protection (Three-Level SPD)**
 - Level 1 SPD:** Installed at the main distribution box to absorb high-energy surges from lightning or grid disturbances, diverting most surge current to the earth.
 - Level 2 SPD:** Installed at secondary distribution boxes to protect sensitive equipment from residual surges.
 - Level 3 SPD:** Installed at tertiary boxes or directly at critical equipment to eliminate micro transient overvoltages, ensuring stable operation of sensitive electronics.
- Structural and Environmental Protection**
 - Rainproof and durable enclosures for outdoor installations.
 - Double doors and coated surfaces for added safety and longevity.
