

Qualification Standards for Secondary Distribution Boxes

Qualified secondary distribution boxes must meet safety, accessibility, material, and installation standards to ensure reliable and secure power distribution. Key Requirements

- 1. Accessibility and Safety** Secondary distribution boxes (SDBs) must be accessible only to qualified personnel. Installations with exposed live parts should be enclosed in a vault, room, or fenced area with controlled access, typically with locks or equivalent security measures. For voltages over 600 V, entrances must remain locked or under observation by a qualified person at all times. Metal-enclosed switchgear, transformers, and connection boxes should be clearly marked with caution signs, and guards must be provided if exposed to potential physical damage from traffic or other hazards (29 CFR 1926.403).
- 2. Enclosure Materials and Construction** Non-concrete enclosures are suitable for areas with incidental vehicular traffic and residential or small commercial applications. They must comply with material specifications, have slip-resistant covers, and be labeled with manufacturer and utility identification (PG&E standards). Concrete enclosures are required in areas subject to full vehicular traffic. They must meet ASTM C-857 standards, have interchangeable joints and covers, and maintain high friction, slip-resistant surfaces. Enclosures should be powder-coated or concrete-colored, with all parts interchangeable and properly labeled for identification.
- 3. Electrical Design and Ratings** Secondary distribution boxes typically include low-voltage equipment, transformers, and terminal blocks for custom wiring. They receive power from the main distribution box and distribute it to branch circuits. Close coupling of transformers and secondary switchboards minimizes cable lengths, improving efficiency and reducing fault currents.
