- Fiber Broadband Association (FBA) certifications, such as the CFHP program, which focuses on fiber-to-the-home (FTTH) and fiber-to-the-building (FTTB) systems.

Some construction sites may require a Construction Skills Certification Scheme (CSCS) card.
