

Rack network reboot



Overview

In the browser window, type <your appliance's IP address>/rest/appliance/resetconfig in the URL address bar. Until the restart is complete, the Web UI is not available. The MyRackspace Portal now has a new reboot option for network devices. You can also use this option when your device experiences security. On any of these APC Rack PDUs, under normal circumstances rebooting the management interface will not affect the outlets or cause them to reboot. I was under the impression as well if you log out or your session expires (and no other users are logged in), it will also automatically do the reboot. This menu gives you the option to reset and reboot various components of the network interface. determine how this device obtains TCP/IP and the EAPoL configuration values. See below for additional. To ensure that software is in a known-correct state, running a cold or warm reboot sequence may be required. Rebooting an AP temporarily turns off any active networks that the AP is providing and disconnects wireless clients that are connected to these networks.
