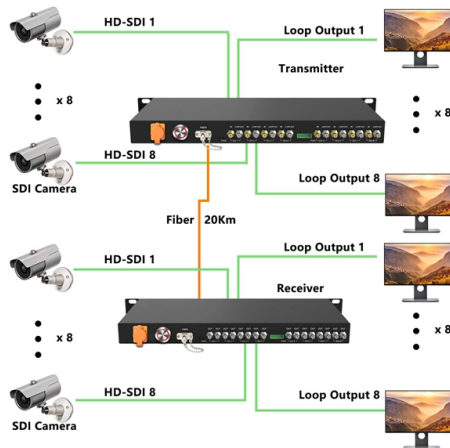


Regulations for the Construction of Communication Towers
