

Relay protection panel reset

Mechanical Relays: Press the reset button or operate the mechanical reset lever on the relay device. If no button is available, manually open and close the relay contacts a few times.

Microprocessor or Electronic Relays: Use the front panel interface, HMI, or remote SCADA system to acknowledge and reset the lockout/trip condition. Some relays allow a digital input or keypad command to release latched outputs.

Motor Protection Relays (e.g., 857 series): Press and hold the Cancel button for a few seconds or use the Enter key to release latched indicators and output protection elements.

Step 4: Restore Power and Circuits After resetting the relay, reconnect the power source and ensure all protection and control circuits are restored to normal. Remove any applied grounds and reclose circuit breakers according to standard operating procedures.

Step 5: Verify Operation Confirm that the relay has reset and that no trip or lockout indications remain. Monitor the system for abnormal conditions to ensure safe and reliable operation.

Additional Tips Document all actions taken, including fault diagnosis, repairs, and relay reset. Understand the relay's function and wiring to troubleshoot effectively. For HT/LT panels, the 86 lockout relay is commonly used to prevent automatic reclosure until the fault is cleared.
