Overload Protection: Circuit breakers, GFCI outlets, or RCDs must be included to protect against overloads. Breakers should be easily accessible for operation and maintenance ().

Insulation and Materials: All insulation must be self-extinguishing. Steel plates and structural components should be degreased, derusted, phosphatized, and treated for corrosion resistance. Anti-corrosion measures are req...
