This is the most desirable outcome but less common due to timing and product lifecycle constraints. Secondary Markets: Items that cannot be resold as new may be sent to secondary channels, including resale platforms, refurbished goods programs, liquidation partners, or donations. These options recover some value but often at a discount and with reduced control over pricing and customer experience. Disposal or Recycling: Items that are damaged, expired, or otherwise unsellable may be recycled or discarded. This is the least profitable outcome and incurs additional costs for handling and disposal. Special Considerations Pharmaceutical Returns: In pharmacies, reverse distribution services handle expired or unsold medications. Options include onsite services where trained personnel manage the return process...
