Column 37 – Customs Procedure Codes: Specify the current and previous customs procedure codes. If the item is declared for the first time, enter “00” for the previous procedure. Item Tracking: For items requiring customs tracking, assign an item tracking code and enable package-specific tracking in your inventory system. Additional Considerations Customs Payments: Duties, taxes, and processing fees must be calculated based on the declared value and classification. Special Procedures: Temporary import, re-export, or other special customs procedures may apply depending on the shipment. Compliance...
