- Primary distribution delivers high-voltage power from substations to distribution transformers.
- Secondary distribution converts this power to low voltage (usually below 1 kV) and distributes it to end-users via secondary mains or service drops.
- The secondary distribution box acts as a hub for these secondary circuits, ensuring that electricity reaches residential, commercial, or industrial loads safely and efficiently.
