

Series connection of wires in the distribution box



AI Overview

Wires in a distribution box are generally connected in parallel, not in series, to ensure each load receives full voltage independently. Understanding Series vs Parallel in a Distribution Box

In a typical home distribution box, the main supply (phase and neutral) enters the main MCB or main switch. From there, the output is routed to an RCCB for protection against earth faults, and then to individual branch MCBs for each load or circuit. Each branch MCB receives the phase wire from the RCCB output, while the neutral wire is connected to a neutral bus bar. The earth wires from all loads and the supply are connected to the earth bus bar. Although the wiring from one MCB to the next may physically resemble a series or “daisy-chain,” electrically, each load is connected in parallel. This ensures that every appliance or circuit receives the full supply voltage, and a fault in one branch does not affect the others.

Connection Steps

Main Supply Connection: Connect the incoming phase and neutral wires to the input terminals of the main MCB.

RCCB Connection: Connect the output of the main MCB to the input of the RCCB.

Branch MCBs: For single-pole MCBs, connect the phase wire from the RCCB output to the MCB input. For double-pole MCBs, connect both phase and neutral from the RCCB output to the MCB input.

Load Wiring: Connect the phase terminal of the load to the output of the MCB. Connect the neutral to the neutral bus bar and the earth to the earth bus bar.

Key Points

Parallel Wiring: Each load is independently connected to the supply, which is crucial for consistent voltage and safety.

Neutral and Earth Links: All neutral wires are tied to a neutral bus bar, and all earth wires are tied to an earth bus bar.

Safety: Always turn off the main supply before wiring, and verify connections with a voltage tester. In summary, while the physical routing of wires may appear sequential, distribution bo...
