

Should the optical module be connected to fiber optic cable or network cable

Without this connection, the module cannot complete the data transmission path. Exceptions and Alternatives Some optical modules can also work with Direct Attach Copper (DAC) cables, which are twin-axial copper cables with SFP connectors on both ends. These allow short-distance connections without fiber, typically within racks or between nearby switches (Weunion Guide) . However, for long-distance or high-speed optical transmission, a fiber optic cable is required. Summary In most cases, an optical module needs to be plugged into a fiber optic cable to function as intended. The only exception is when using DAC or AOC cables for short-range elect...
