For aluminum trays, use insulated conductors with exposed ends for bonding to avoid electrolytic corrosion. Material Handling and Inspection Before installation, all cable trays, ladders, and accessories should be inspected for physical damage, coating integrity, and compliance with approved submittals. Materials should be stored horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports at one-meter intervals, protected from moisture and sunlight. A Material Inspection Request (MIR) should be submitted for approval prior to installation. Installation Procedure Review Documentation: Verify approved shop drawings, material submittals, and Inspection & Test Plans (ITPs) to ensure alignment with project specifications. Site Preparation: Clear and clean the installation area, provide safe access, and barricade work zones. Conduct safety briefings and toolbox talks for all personnel. Support and Fixing: Install supports, brackets, and hangers as per manufacturer recommendations and project drawings. Ensure proper alignment and secure fastening of trays and ladders. Cable Routing: Route cables according to system requirements and load calculations, maintaining separation for power and data cables where necessary. Avoid sharp bends and mechanical stress on cables
