This compatibility ensures that elbows integrate seamlessly with straight sections without creating gaps or reducing cable capacity.

Material and Construction

Elbows are generally made from the same material as the straight tray sections, such as aluminum alloys (6063-T5 or 5052-H34) or steel, to maintain uniform strength and corrosion resistance. Ventilated or solid designs are available depending on the application, with standard spacing maintained through the middle of the fitting for proper cable support.

Practical Considerations

When selecting elbows, it is important to consider:

- Cable bend radius:** Ensure the elbow radius is sufficient to prevent cable damage.
- Load capacity:** Elbows must support the same cable weight as straight sections.
- Installation space:** Larger radii require more physical space for routing.
- Future expansion:** Choosing slightly larger elbows can facilitate additional c...
