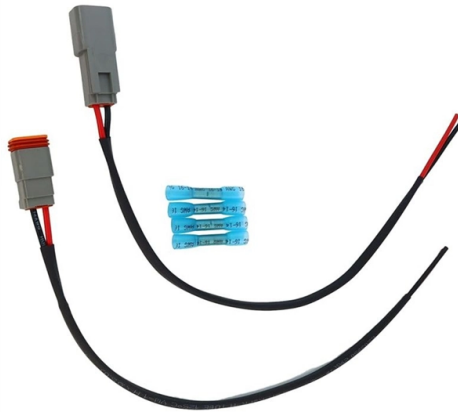

Deflection is calculated based on simple spans, with continuous spans reducing deflection by up to 50%. Rungs are designed to handle heavy loads while maintaining structural integrity.
