Load and Safety Requirements Fiberglass trays must meet Safe Working Load (SWL) requirements as per IEC 61537, with load vs. span ratings based on maximum deflection at mid-span. A safety factor of 1.5 is standard, ensuring the tray can support 1.5 times the allowable working load. Straight ladder-type trays consist of two longitudinal side rails connected by transverse rungs, with rung spacing typically 6–9 inches for instrumentation and control applications.
