Environmental and Installation Considerations Terminal boxes should be installed in dry, ventilated, and non-corrosive environments, avoiding high humidity, extreme temperatures, or dust accumulation. For outdoor installations, boxes should meet IP65 or higher ratings to prevent water and dust ingress. In corrosive environments, such as coastal or chemical plants, silicone sealing rings can protect against salt spray and extend service life.

Inspection and Cleaning Regular inspection is critical. Recommended practices include: Quarterly checks for cracks, deformation, and aging of sealing strips. Temperature rise testing, ensuring it does not exceed ambient temperature plus 30°C. Cleaning with dry compressed air; wet cloths or chemical solvents should be avoided to prevent oxidation. In high-dust environments, conductive paste can reduce contact resistance and prevent terminal failures.

Wiring and Operational Standards Proper wiring ensures reliability: Control stripping length (typically 5–8 mm) and use a torque screwdriver to tighten screws according to spe...
