Routing and Securing Fibers: Plan the fiber path inside the box to avoid tension when the front panel is pulled out. Maintain a minimum bend radius and use cable ties or movable clips to secure fibers without crushing them. Ensure the cable length allows for full panel extension without stress.

Connecting to Network Devices

Optical Network Terminal (ONT): In home installations, the ONT converts the fiber signal to Ethernet. Place it near a power source and networking hardware for efficient distribution.

Patch Cables: Use LC, SC, or other compatible connectors to link the distribution box to routers, switches, or other network devices. Verify proper alignment to prevent signal loss.

Best Practices

- Avoid sharp bends, high-traffic areas, and extreme temperatures to protect fiber integrity.
- Label cables and ports for easier troubleshooting and future expansion.
- Use a Visual Fault Locator (VFL) to check for breaks or excessive bending...
