Material and Design Considerations Enclosure materials: UV-stabilized ABS or polycarbonate plastics are recommended for durability, impact resistance, and long-term outdoor use. Mounting: Boxes should be elevated or mounted on stands to prevent water pooling at the base. Covers and latches: Proven gaskets and secure latching mechanisms maintain a tight seal even after repeated openings. Sockets and wiring: Industrial CEE sockets (IEC 60309) are commonly used, and internal wiring should be organized to prevent water ingress and accidental contact.
