

Standard wiring requirements for household electrical distribution boxes

- Mounting the Box: Mark the installation points, drill holes, and secure the box with expansion bolts. Ensure it is level and stable; use waterproof boxes for outdoor installations.
- Wire Preparation: Strip insulation to the correct length, avoiding excessive exposure that could cause short circuits.
- Connecting Wires: Phase (Live) wires to the corresponding terminals on MCBs or RCDs; Neutral wires to the neutral busbar; Ground (Earth) wires to the ground busbar. Ensure tight, secure connections and proper spacing for heat dissipation.
- Circuit Layout: Connect the main supply to the double-pole MCB or main isolator, then distribute to individual circuits via single-pole MCBs.
- Labeling: Clearly label each circuit for easy identification and future maintenance.
