- Connect conductors to the correct terminals: line to line, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground, following color coding standards.
- Dress and route wires neatly inside the enclosure, securing them with cable ties and leaving space for heat dissipation.

Testing and Verification

- Insulation resistance test:** Measure resistance between wiring and the box to ensure it meets required values.
- Circuit on/off test:** Verify each circuit for continuity and absence of short circuits using a multimeter.
- Component verification:** Confirm that all breakers, fuses, and other components are correctly rated and operational.
