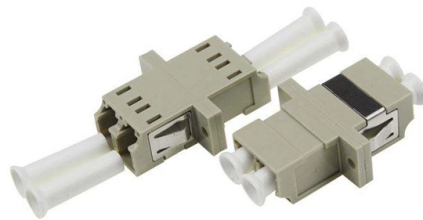

Large-Scale SANs: Core directors or multi-switch fabrics with high port density (128+ ports) support enterprise-scale storage, high availability, and backbone connectivity.
