Fittings and Accessories: Fittings such as bends, T-pieces, crossovers, and reducers allow the tray to change direction or branch off. Accessories like covers, barrier strips, and cable protection rings help organize, separate, and protect cables from mechanical damage or environmental factors.

Materials and Protection Cable trays are typically made from steel, aluminum, or FRP/GRP. Steel provides high strength, aluminum offers lightweight corrosion resistance, and FRP/GRP ensures electrical insulation and excellent corrosion resistance. Covers or solid bases can be added to protect sensitive cables from dust, moisture, or electromagnetic interference.
