- Fiber Network Expansion:** Fiber SFP modules allow switches to connect over single-mode or multi-mode fiber, extending network reach beyond copper limitations.
- Versatile Network Design:** SFP slots enable network administrators to mix and match fiber and copper connections, providing scalability and adaptability in enterprise or industrial networks.
