

# Switch SFP Optical Module Selection

**Other Technical Factors:** Compatibility also depends on fiber type (single-mode vs multimode), wavelength, distance, and environmental grade. Using mismatched modules can result in alarms, link failures, or reduced performance.

**Practical Example:** A 1000BASE-SX SFP module can be inserted into an SFP+ port on a 10G switch to establish a 1Gbps link, but a 10G SFP+ module cannot operate in a 1G SFP port.

**Verify Port Speed:** Ensure the module speed matches or is compatible with the switch port.

**Confirm Fiber Type and Wavelength:** Match single-mode or multimode fiber and the correct wavelength for the link distance.
