The fiber enters the home and terminates at a Fiber Termination Unit (FTU) or Optical Network Terminal (ONT). From the FTU/ONT, you can either:

- Connect directly to a fiber switch using an SFP module, or
- Connect to a media converter, then to a standard Ethernet switch.

From the switch, you can distribute the network to multiple devices via Ethernet or additional fiber runs.
