

Temperature of cable trays



Overview

Polyester and Vinyl Ester cable trays are non-metallic, or in a very simple sense, plastic. A good understanding of how materials perform at extreme temperatures is critical to avoid serious injuries and expensive downtime. It explains typical causes of fire, outlines technical and organisational solutions, and provides recommendations for installation. In 1993 NEC Article 318 there are no requirements for the handling of the thermal contraction and expansion of cable tray. This subject is addressed in the NEMA Standards Publication No. VE 1 “Metallic Cable Tray Systems” Section 6.
