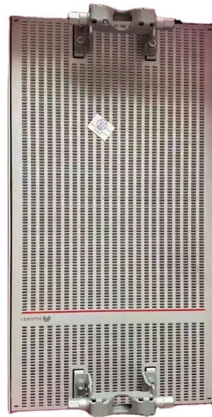


# Testing the functionality of the switch s optical ports

**Monitoring Port and Module Status** Switches often provide commands to check the status of optical modules and ports. For example, on Cisco switches, the `show interface` command displays link state, module type, traffic statistics, and optical power levels. This helps detect coding compatibility issues, verify link speed, and identify errors or abnormal conditions (Moduletek).

Always ensure the transceiver is compatible with the switch and supports the intended speed and connector type to avoid unpredictable behavior (Cisco).

**Optical Power and Sensitivity Testing** For more detailed testing, you can measure TX power, RX sensitivity, and bit error rate (BER) using optical power meters, attenuators, and traffic analyzers. TX power tests measure the output of the transmit port, while RX sensitivity tests determine the minimum signal level the receiver can detect. BER testing evaluates the integrity of transmitted data and error rates. Eye-mask tests can also verify signal quality, jitter, and compliance with standards (EDN).
