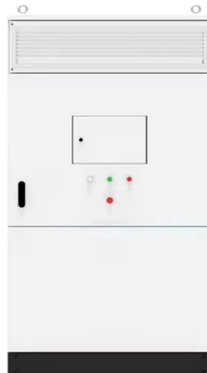

A coupler can be used as a splitter to couple out some portion of the light circulating in the resonator of fiber laser, for example. Directional 2×2 couplers (see Figure 1) are usually used for such purposes. Often fibers must be installed, serviced, or even replaced while the network is still in operation.
