Function of the Optical Module The optical module, often implemented as an SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) or dedicated OLT module, is a key component of the OLT that performs electro-optical conversion. It transmits downstream data from the OLT to the Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) at the customer premises and receives upstream data from these terminals, converting it back into electrical signals for processing by the OLT's CPU and network cards (Ethernet, PON, or voice gateway).

**Role in the PON Architecture** In a Passive Optical Network, the OLT serves as the master device, aggregating multiple ONTs/ONUs through optical splitters. Each optical module is associated with one or more PON ports, and it ensures proper wavelength assignment for upstream (Rx) and downstream (Tx) communication. This allows the OLT to manage traffic, prevent collisions, and coordinate the multiplexing of signals from multiple users.

**Technical Details** Wavelengths: Downstream signals are typically transmitted at 1490 nm, while upstream signals use a different wavelength (e.g., 1310 nm) to avoid interference. Capacity: Each module can support a PON network with split ratios ranging from 1:32 to 1:128, depending on the OLT type and PON standard (GPON, XGS-PON, EPON). Integration: Optical modules can be modular (SFP-based) or integrated into the OLT chassis. Modular designs allow easy...
