Modern distribution boxes often include a Residual Current Device (RCD) to detect leakage currents and enhance safety.

Safety Considerations

- Proper grounding:** All metal parts and the neutral point must be connected to an earth electrode to safely divert fault currents.
- Cable sizing:** The power cord must be rated for the total load to prevent overheating.
- Secure entry:** Use cable glands or clamps to prevent movement and mechanical stress on the connections.
- Environmental protection:** For outdoor or industrial boxes, ensure the enclosure has an appropriate IP rating to resist dust, moisture, and temperature variations.

Types of Distribution Boxes

- Residential:** Smaller boxes for lighting and outlets, typically handling 120/240V circuits.
- Commercial:** Larger boxes with multiple circuits for offices, air conditioning, and equipment.
- Industrial:** Heavy-duty boxes for high-voltage machinery, often with metal enclosures for durability.
