Facilitates Multi-Layer Cable Preparation: In multi-layer cables, each layer (jacket, aramid yarn, buffer) must be stripped progressively to the correct length for proper assembly .

Supports Safety and Efficiency: Using precision tools like mechanical, thermal, or chemical strippers ensures consistent results and reduces the risk of damaging the fiber or surrounding layers .

Typical Stripping Process

Initial Jacket Removal: The outer protective sheath is stripped first.

Buffer and Coating Removal: The primary and secondary coatings are removed to expose the glass core.

Cleaning and Inspection: The stripped fiber is cleaned with alcohol or a suitable solution to remove debris, ensuring a smooth surface for cleaving and termination .

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If your stripper has 2 grooves, use the second groove in the stripper to remove the fiber buffer in 3 steps. This prevents putting excess stress on the fiber and prevents breakage. Don't be discouraged if you
