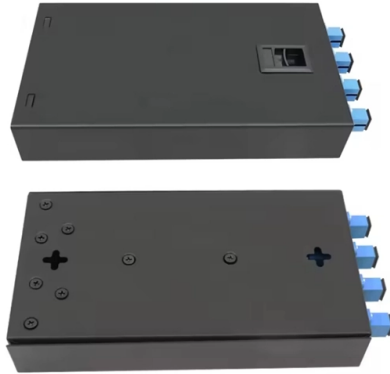

Distance requirements: Different modules support different transmission distances, from a few meters to over 100 km. Hot-swappable: Many modern modules, like SFPs, can be inserted or removed while the switch is powered on, simplifying upgrades and maintenance.
