Connecting Switches to Fiber To connect a switch to a fiber optic cable: Insert the appropriate transceiver into the switch's SFP or QSFP port. Attach the fiber optic cable to the transceiver, ensuring proper alignment of connectors (LC, SC, or BiDi types) for single-mode or multi-mode fiber. Configure the switch to recognize the fiber port and enable data transmission, which may involve setting VLANs or link speeds. If a switch lacks fiber ports, a fiber media converter can be used. This device converts electrical signals from copper Ethernet to optical signals for fiber transmission, extending network reach beyond the 100-meter limitation of copper cables.
