On-Site Installation Considerations

Supports and Mounting: Cable trays are anchored using trapeze hangers, wall brackets, or center-span supports. Proper spacing ensures structural stability and prevents sagging under cable load.

Fittings and Accessories: Bends, tees, risers, and reducers allow the tray to navigate around obstacles and change elevation. Covers protect cables from dust, debris, and moisture, while hold-down clamps secure cables in place.

Sizing and Duty Rating: Correct tray width and depth are critical. Trays should not be filled to capacity to maintain airflow and allow future expansion. Duty ratings—light, medium, or heavy—define load-bearing capacity and must match the cable weight.

Material Selection: Materials such as galvanized steel, aluminum, or stainless steel are chosen based on environmental conditions. Galvanized steel offers corrosion resistance, wh...
