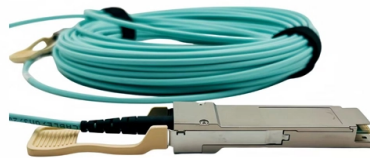

Support Spacing: Long-span trough trays are supported at intervals of 14 to 20 feet, with extra-long spans exceeding 20 feet for outdoor or road-crossing applications. Proper support placement is critical to maintain tray strength and prevent sagging.

Load Capacity: The tray must be selected based on cable weight, environmental loads (wind, snow, ice), and the chosen support span. Corrugated or reinforced bottoms increase stiffness and load-bearing capacity.

Splice Plates: For long spans, splice plates connect tray sections and ensure structural continuity. Their placement is crucial to maintain strength over extended runs.
