- Busbars:** Conductive strips, typically made of aluminium or copper, distribute power to multiple outgoing circuits. Busbars are insulated with PVC sleeves and color-coded for phase identification (R, Y, B) to prevent misconnection.
- Protective Devices:** Circuit breakers or fuses are installed on each outgoing circuit. They automatically interrupt current flow in case of overload or short circuit, protecting both wiring and connected equipment.
- Outgoing Feeders:** Power is delivered to individual circuits via feeder droppers connected to the busbars. The cross-section of these droppers is designed to handle the rated current safely.
- Enclosure:** The box itself is made from thermoplastics (PC, ASA) or powder-coated metal, providing mechanical protection and environmental resistance. Enclosures may be surface-mounted, flush-mounted, or pole-mounted depending on application.
- Optional Smart Features:** Modern DB boxes may include energy monitoring units, communication modules, and smart circuit breakers for real-time monitoring, remote control, and predictive maintenance.
