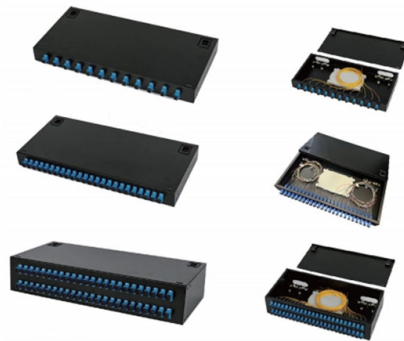


Using the lc fiber optic terminal box

Overview of LC Connectors

LC (Lucent Connector) connectors are small form-factor connectors with a 1.25 mm ferrule, designed for tight spaces and high-density applications. They feature a push-pull latch for easy insertion and removal, and they support both single-mode and multimode fibers. LC connectors offer low insertion loss (0.1–0.3 dB) and high return loss (often over 50 dB), ensuring clear signal transmission in crowded network environments.

Preparing the FiberStrip the Fiber:

Use a fiber optic stripper to remove the outer jacket carefully, exposing the bare fiber without nicking the glass.

Clean the Fiber:

Wipe the exposed fiber with a lint-free alcohol pad or fiber cleaning pen to remove dust, grease, or other contaminants.

Cleaving:

Use a high-precision cleaver to cut the fiber at a 90° angle. Inspect the end face under a microscope to ensure it is smooth and free of cracks.

Connecting the LC Connector

Align the Fiber:

Insert the cleaved fiber into the LC connector's zirconia ferrule, ensuring proper alignment.

Secure the Fiber:

For epoxy-based connectors, inject a small amount of fast-curing epoxy. For connectors with integrated crimp, use the appropriate hand tool to clamp the fiber.

Polish the Connector Tip:

Use fiber optic polishing film to achieve a smooth finish for optimal contact and minimal insertion loss.

Using the Terminal Box

Insert Connectors:

Remove dust caps from both the LC connector and the terminal box port. Insert the connector until the latch clicks, confirming proper engagement.

Duplex Connections:

Ensure transmit and receive fibers are correctly paired for duplex links.

Organize Cables:

Use the box's internal guides or spools to manage fiber slack and prevent bending beyond the minimum bend radius.

Verifying the Connection

Power Meter:

Measure optical loss across the connection to ensure signal integrity.

OTDR Testing:

For critical or long-distance links, use an Optical Time Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) to verify the connection.
