Checking Fiber Port Status Use `show interface status` to list all interfaces and identify fiber ports, often labeled as "Gi" (Gigabit Ethernet) or "Fiber". For detailed information on a specific port, run `show interface` (e.g., `GigabitEthernet1/0/1`). This shows speed, duplex, link state, and media type. To verify connectivity, ensure the port shows "up" status. If down, check the physical connection and SFP module.

Viewing SFP/Transceiver Details Use `show inventory` to see installed SFPs, including Product ID, Version ID, and Serial Number. For optical diagnostics, run `show interfaces transceiver detail` or `show interface transceiver detail`. This provides Tx/Rx power, temperature, voltage, and bias current. To read EEPROM/vendor information, use `show idprom interface` or `show idprom transceiver extended`.

Troubleshooting Tips If the SFP does not appear, reseal the module or check compatibility with the switch. Monitor Digital Diagnostic Monitoring (DDM) values to detect signal degradation early. High or low alarms indicate potential issues. For third-party modules blocked by the switch, commands like `no errdisable detect cause gbic-invalid` may resolve errors, but follow vendor guidance.

Physical Inspection Inspect fiber connectors for dust, dirt, or damage. Clean connectors if necessary. Use a fiber optic power meter or OTDR to measure optical power and detect faults in the fiber cable. By combining CLI commands with physical inspection, you can effectively monitor, verify, and troubleshoot fiber optic connections on your switch.
