

Wall-mounted trapezoidal cable tray fixing method

Use appropriate fasteners for the wall type (e.g., concrete anchors for masonry walls or bolts for steel structures). Ensure brackets are rated for the tray load, including the weight of cables.

Support Spacing Support spacing is critical to prevent sagging and maintain safety. For trapezoidal trays, typical wall bracket spacing ranges from 1.5 to 3 meters, depending on tray width, material, and cable load. Heavier loads or wider trays require closer spacing. Always follow manufacturer specifications for maximum load per bracket.

Installation Steps

- Mark the Wall:** Use a level to mark bracket positions along the planned tray route.
- Install Brackets:** Secure cantilever brackets to the wall using appropriate anchors, ensuring they are level and aligned.
- Place the Tray:** Position the trapezoidal tray on the brackets, ensuring it sits flush and level.
- Secure the Tray:** Use tray clamps or bolts to fasten the tray to the brackets, preventing movement.
- Check Alignment:** Verify that the tray is straight and level along the entire run. Adjust brackets if necessary.
